During my career in the Foreign Service, I worked on official development assistance (ODA), economic diplomacy, and international exchange. 授業の内容 / Course Description	<p>This course will provide students with a comprehensive understanding of the complex dimensions of globalization at the local, national, and international levels. Students will research and present economic, environmental, cultural, and educational aspects of globalization in groups and discuss the interconnectedness of globalization as it currently affects us and is changing the world. Some games will be introduced to facilitate understanding of global challenges and interaction among students.</p>		
授業の達成目標 / Course Goals	<p>At the end of the course, participants are expected to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) express their ideas about global issues; 2) analyze the global interconnectedness of our world; 3) be responsible global citizens; and 4) enjoy communicating in English.

前提とする知識 / Prerequisites	<p>There are no prerequisites for this course. This class doesn't need advanced level English skills, so please don't hesitate to join this English-speaking class! In this class, we help each other to learn more about ourselves and our societies. Be active and have a fun!</p> <p>Also, this class intends for the students who are planning to go study abroad, or to join overseas internship program, or to do volunteer activities abroad, even though they are not yet good at English.</p>

授業の具体的な進め方 / Course Methodologies	<p>This course will be a series of workshops consisting mainly of group work and game activities, followed by some lectures. Active participation will be encouraged. On the first day, come prepared to brainstorm and think about globalization around you. At the end of each day, students will write a short essay on the topic of the day (essay writing instructions will be provided in class). The following day, students will be asked to share these essays in groups. The following schedule is tentative and subject to change based on enrollment and workshop progress.</p>

成績評価の方法 / Evaluation	"End of day essays 60% (20% each day) Active participation in group work and presentation 40%"
学習上の助言 / Learning Advice	When you communicate, it is more important to have the "willingness to communicate" than to have perfect pronunciation and vocabulary. Even if you speak with a slight accent or make mistakes, you can still communicate effectively. This course will help you gain confidence by providing opportunities to practice your language skills, as well as the basic knowledge of globalization necessary to understand the interconnected world.
